ORDER VARYING THE CLOSE TIME AND QUOTA FOR RECREATIONAL FISHING FOR GROUNDFISH IN DIVISION 4T

#### Short Title

1. This Order may be cited as the Gulf Region Close Time and Quota Variation Order 2018-035.

#### Variation

- 2. Gulf Region Close Time and Quota Variation Order 2018-010 is hereby revoked.
- 3. The close time as fixed by subsection 91(1) of the Atlantic Fishery Regulations, 1985 is hereby varied so that no person shall engage in recreational fishing for groundfish in the waters of Division 4T as set out in column I of Table I, during the close times as set out in column II of Table I of this Order.
- 4. The quota as fixed by subsection 91(3) of the Atlantic Fishery Regulations, 1985 is hereby varied so that no person engaged in recreational fishing for groundfish shall, on any day, catch and retain more than a quota of groundfish of all species in the aggregate except skate, halibut, northern wolffish, Atlantic wolffish and spotted wolffish of which the daily quota is varied to zero, as set out in column III of Table I of this Order in the waters of Division 4T as set out in column I of Table I of this Order.

5. The quota as fixed by paragraph 91(3)(a) and 91(3)(b) of the Atlantic Fishery Regulations, 1985 is hereby varied so that no person engaged in recreational fishing for groundfish shall, on any day, catch and retain more than a quota of groundfish of all species in the aggregate as set out in column III of Table I of this Order in the waters of Division 4T as set out in column I of Table I of this Order.

#### Coming Into Force

6. This Order shall come into force on the date of signature and remains in force until January 31, 2019, unless otherwise revoked, at which time the close time and quota shall revert to those set out in section 91 of the said Regulations.
