2006-2008 Summary of Beluga Management Plan (Revised February 2008)

Management measures for Areas where hunting is allowed

- Respect of the Total Allowable Catch (TAC) for each and every hunting area;
- **In case of overharvesting in an area, its TAC for the following year will be reduced by the equivalent quantity to help ensure recovery of beluga numbers;**
 - Hudson Strait pilot project: in case of overharvesting could be jeopardized;
- Ottawa Island 2008 pilot project: if all belugas caught are not sampled or if it is determined they belong to the Eastern Hudson Bay population, **no future hunting will be authorized** in that area;
 - The estuaries of the Mucalic, Nastapoka and Little Whale River remain closed all year;
 - Mandatory Communal Hunting Plan for each community provided by local HFTA to DFO;
- Mandatory Hunting Plans for each of the 3 pilot projects provided by NHFTA to DF) - one for the hunt in Nottingham and ; Salisbury Islands area, one for the winter Hudson Strait area and one for the Ottawa Island area;
 - Protection of females, calves and juveniles;
 - Control of netting, harpoon first, use of appropriate rifles;
 - No waste of muktuk and meat, sharing of edible parts;
 - Mandatory sampling of tooth and skin for each beluga captured;
- Hunting samples must be returned by local HFTA to the Nunavik Research Center.
